## **THE TUSKEGEE AIRMEN The African American Pilots of WWII**

Between 1941 and 1946, roughly 1,000 black pilots were trained at a segregated air base in Tuskegee, AL The Tuskegee Airmen flew hundreds of patrol and attack missions for the Twelfth Air Force, flying P-40 and P-39 airplanes, before they were reassigned to the 15th Air Force to escort B-17 and B-24 heavy bombers, using P-47 and P-51 airplanes
